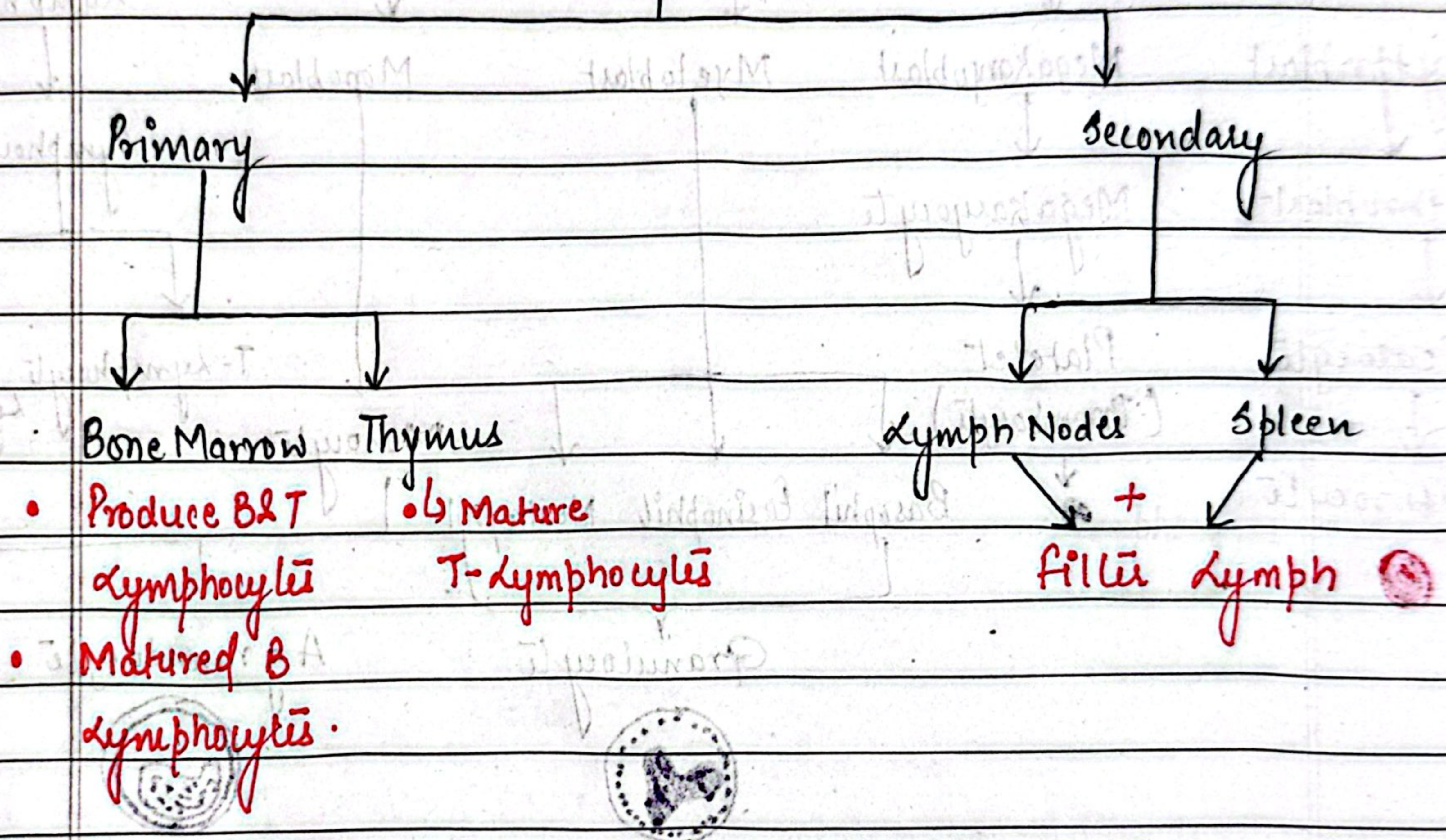


Lymphatic System

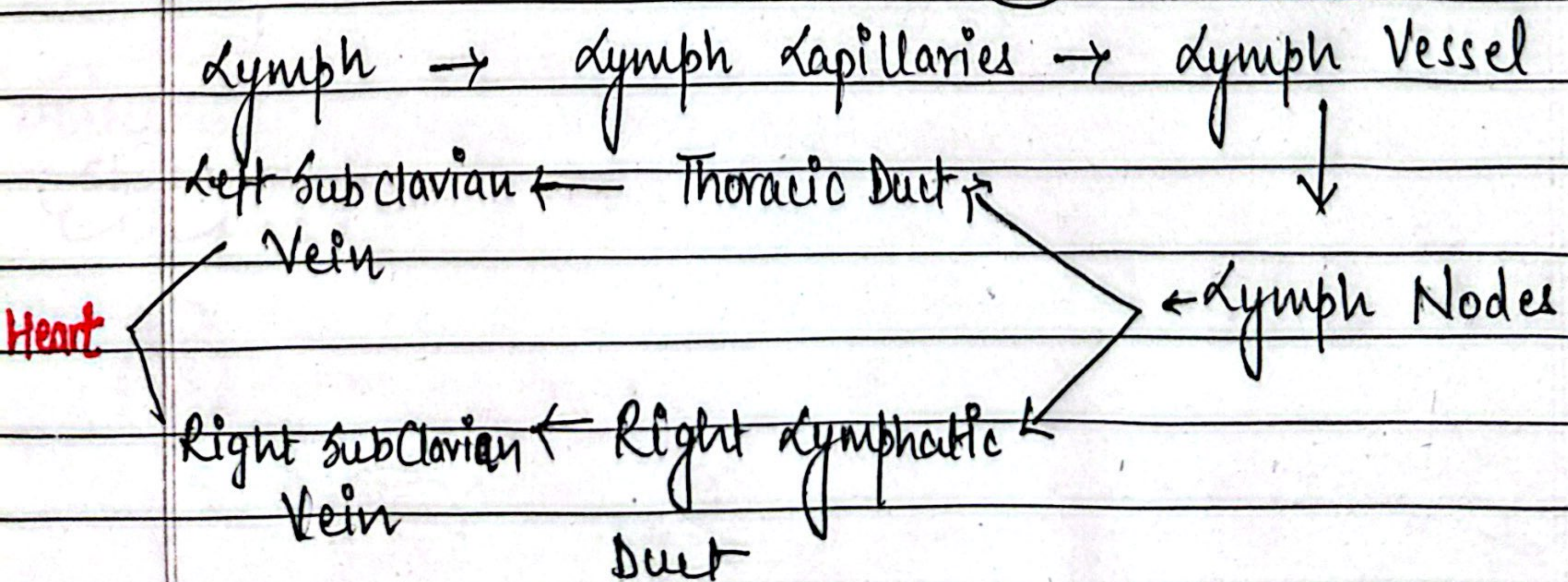
→ The lymphatic system is a network of tubes and organs that runs through out the body. It is the part of the immune system and circulatory system, which helps to protect from infection.

*	Difference between Lymphatic System & Blood Circulatory System
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S.No.	Lymph System	Blood Circulatory System.
1.	Oneway path	Circular
2.	Approx 4L/day	Approx 5L/min.
3.	fluid moved by intrinsic contraction of lymph collector	fluid moved by central pump (heart) and call muscle pump.
4.	No continuous column of fluid	Continuous Column of fluid.
5.	lymph is filtered by lymph Nodes	Blood is filtered by the Kidneys, liver and spleen.
